

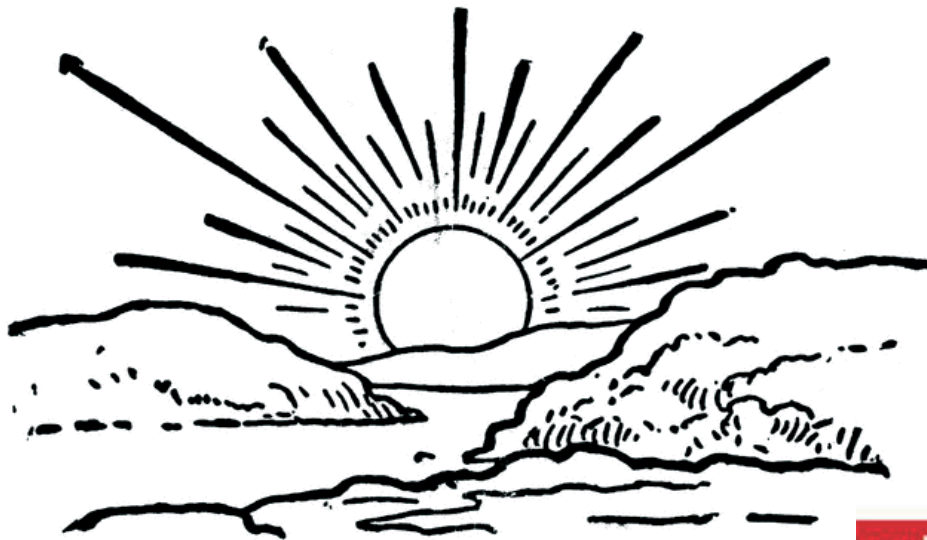
Queen's Park Singers and Junior Singers cordially invite you to join us for **refreshments** after the performance.

O Radiant Dawn

In 2007 the American composer Morten Lauridsen received the National Medal of Arts from the President of the USA in a White House ceremony 'for his composition of radiant choral works combining musical beauty, power and spiritual depth that have thrilled audiences worldwide'. The creation of luminous sound-worlds has been a particular feature of choral music written in recent times, and of course composers of earlier periods have also shared that interest.

Following the well-received performances of Britten's *Noye's Fludde* given at St Mark's last November by our Junior choir, Queens Park Singers is very pleased to perform here for the first time, in a programme of music specially chosen to suit the spacious acoustics of this church.
